Hello, Coaches!

AYSO Region 24 is proud to invite your team to the 17<sup>th</sup> Annual KICKOFF CLASSIC Tournament

- Scope:** AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.
- When:** Saturday & Sunday, February 28<sup>th</sup> and March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 – Rain Dates March 7<sup>th</sup> and 08<sup>th</sup> 2015
- Where:** The tournament will be held at Griffith Middle School, Maude Price and Downey Complex
- Who:** AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-19, U-16 (11v11) 18 players max. U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered and have played in the AYSO 2011 primary season. Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.
- What:** Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed 3 games in pool play. The top teams will advance to the medal round on Sunday afternoon. All games will be as follows: (60 min. for U-19 & U-16, 50 min. for U-14, 50 min for U-12, and 40 min for U-10).
- Why:** The KICKOFF CLASSIC Tournament is being conducted as a fundraiser by Cultural Exchange Teams.
- Awards:** All players and 2 coaches per team will receive a tournament pin. All players on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & 4<sup>th</sup> place teams will receive a medal. A Team Trophy will be awarded to the coach of the winning team in each age division.
- Entry Fee, Refunds:** \$475 for U-19 & U-16, \$475 for U-14 & U-12, and \$425 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws before January 29, 2015, a full refund is given. Withdrawals after January 29, 2015, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.
- Referee Fee, Refunds:** \$200 refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament. Partial refunds will be given based upon the number of game slots completed.
- Rules:** A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.
- Acceptance:** The application deadline is January 27<sup>th</sup>. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs. of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.
- How:** Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, along with the tournament application, referee information form, and team roster to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional commissioner must sign application and team roster. Appropriate referee administrator must sign referee information form. See referee form for details.

## Application Instructions

Applications are now being accepted for entrance into the AYSO 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Kickoff Classic Tournament.

The deadline to enter the tournament is **Jan 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015**. Applications accepted by that date will be given priority for acceptance into the tournament; all others will be accepted based on any available openings.

Applications will be accepted on a first-come basis, based on a completed application. To be considered complete, your application must include all of the following:

1. Team Application Form, signed by the Head Coach and the Regional Commissioner.
2. Team Roster Form signed by your Regional Commissioner.

### Roster Notes:

- i Alternatively, an eAYSO Roster form will be accepted, however it must include the names of the Head Coach and Assistant Coach and be signed by your Regional Commissioner.
- i Roster changes will be allowed up until Team Check-in; after that, no roster changes. All roster changes must be approved by your Regional Commissioner.
- i Rosters must be comprised solely of players who were registered and played in the AYSO 2014 primary program.
- i Up to 3 guest players may be added to your roster from a neighboring AYSO Region. In this case, the guest player's Regional Commissioner must sign the roster.

i Player roster limits are as follows:

U-19/U-16	18 players max	11-v-11 play
U-14	15 players max	11-v-11 play
U-12	12 players max	9-v-9 play
U-10	10 players max	7-v-7 play

3. The completed Referee Form signed by your Regional Referee Administrator (if you're not planning to bring referees, just check the box on the Referee Form and return it without the RRA signature).
4. A single region check for the total amount of the Team Entry Fee and the Referee Commitment Fee.

If your application is not accepted, you will be offered the opportunity to be placed on a waiting list, or if you prefer we will return your application to you within 48 hours of your decision.

**Refund:** if you withdraw before January 29, 2015, a full refund will be issued. If you withdraw after that time, we will only issue a refund if a replacement team can be found, less any cost to register that replacement team.

CATEGORY	RULE
<b>Tournament Invitation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Your team is invited to participate in the 17<sup>th</sup> annual Kickoff Classic. This is an AYSO invitational tournament open to all AYSO U10-U19 Divisions boy &amp; girl teams. The age determination will be July 31, 2014</li> <li>❖ All games will be played Saturday &amp; Sunday February 28<sup>th</sup> and March 1<sup>st</sup> for all divisions. The tournament will be extended to the following weekend "if necessary" between March 07<sup>th</sup> and 08<sup>th</sup>, due to inclement weather.</li> </ul>
<b>1) JURISDICTION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Unless otherwise noted, the current AYSO National Rules and Regulations, Section 11 and FIFA Laws of the Game will be used for this tournament. The following rules are intended specifically for this tournament ONLY!</li> <li>B. The Tournament Committee (incl. Tournament Director, Assistant Director(s), Field Director, Referee Director and other designated staff) will have jurisdiction over all games played. Disputes will be resolved by the end of the soccer day. Referee judgment calls are NOT subject to dispute or protest!</li> </ul>
<b>2) FEES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Entire entry fee and referee deposit must accompany tournament application and will be returned if application is not accepted. Fee and deposit must be a single check issued from the Region's account (no personal checks, money orders, credit cards, etc.).  Fees are: U10 \$625 (\$425 entry fee plus \$200 referee deposit), U12 \$675 (\$475 entry fee plus \$200 referee deposit), U14 \$675 (\$475 entry fee plus \$200 referee deposit), U16/U19 \$675 (\$475 entry fee plus \$200 referee deposit).</li> </ul>
<b>3) ACCEPTANCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Applications are due on January 27<sup>th</sup> , 2015</li> <li>B. Applications will be accepted on a first-come basis, based on completed application (see Team Application Form for criteria). Teams will be notified by email within 48 hours of the receipt of their applications.</li> <li>C. Teams not accepted into the tournament will be offered the opportunity to be placed on a waiting list. If a team chooses not to be on a waiting list, the application and entry fee will be returned within 48 hours of notification.</li> <li>D. The primary form of communication between the Tournament and applying teams will be email and the Tournament website. Teams must designate a Team Contact on their application who has email and Internet access.</li> </ul>
<b>4) REFUNDS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Teams withdrawing before January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2015 will be issued a full refund.</li> <li>B. Teams withdrawing after January 29<sup>th</sup>. 2015 will only be issued a refund if a replacement team can be found.</li> <li>C. If the tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled a full refund will be issued.</li> <li>D. For teams that are eligible, referee deposit refunds will be mailed no later than 14 days after the end of the tournament. Referee deposit refunds will be on a prorated basis, comparing the number of assignments actually completed versus the number that were assigned.</li> </ul>
<b>5) RAINOUT/ CANCELLATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Should the tournament be rained out on the original date, it will be rescheduled to the weekend of March 07<sup>th</sup> and 08<sup>th</sup>, 2015. All teams will be expected to return on that date to resume the tournament. Any team not able to return will only receive a refund if a replacement team can be found, less the cost of any pre-ordered items (items for sale by the tournament which are not included with the registration fee). Any pre-ordered items will be sent to the team.</li> <li>B. If the tournament is cancelled due to weather after partially completing and it cannot be rescheduled to be completed, refunds will be made to teams on a prorated basis, based on the number of actual games played.</li> <li>C. If the tournament cannot be held due to weather or other conditions beyond the control of the tournament hosts, then a full refund will be sent to all teams, less the cost of any pre-ordered items (items for sale by the tournament which are not included with the registration fee). Any pre-ordered items will be sent to the team.</li> </ul>
<b>6) PLAYERS/TEAMS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Players on participating teams must be properly registered to play in AYSO, and have played in the Fall 2014 season in a minimum of one-half of the games for which they were eligible. Coaches are responsible to ensure that all players meet eligibility requirements.</li> <li>B. The team roster must be verified and approved by each player's Regional Commissioner. Roster changes may be submitted (with the written approval of the Regional Commissioner); however, these changes must be received by the Tournament Registrar prior to the tournament. There will be no roster changes allowed on tournament day.</li> <li>C. 3 Guest Players (players from a different Region from the applying team's Region) will be allowed for each team. However, the Guest Player will be required to have the approval of both the Guest Player's Regional Commissioner</li> </ul>

	<p>and the Host Team Regional Commissioner (see Guest Player Form).</p> <p>D. Coed teams will be accepted; however they must play in the boys' divisions only.</p> <p>E. Divisions U16 and U19 will play 11-v-11, and there will be a roster limit of 18 players per team. Division U14 will play 11-v-11, and there will be a roster limit of 15 players per team. Division U12 will play 9-v-9, and there will be a roster limit of 12 players per team. Division U10 will play 7-v-7, and there will be a roster limit of 10 players per team.</p> <p>F. All players must play at least half of each game. Violation of these player rules exposes a team to protest and renders them subject to forfeiture of game and possible disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director.</p>
<b>7) COACHES</b>	<p>A. Each team is limited to two coaches but must have two – one Head Coach and one Assistant Coach.. These coaches must be the ones listed on the Official Team Roster.</p> <p>B. Each Coach must provide their AYSO Identification Number, be a currently registered volunteer, Safe-Haven certified and be AYSO trained at the age-appropriate level.</p> <p>C. Coaches are expected to set the example for their team in exhibiting proper AYSO behavior and Kids Zone behavior. Coaches are expected to remain in the technical area during games and only enter the field of play as requested by the referee.</p>
<b>8) REFEREES</b>	<p>A. Each team in the tournament will provide a crew of 3 referees. These referees will be assigned up to 3 games, based on their qualifications.</p> <p>B. All referees must be an AYSO currently registered and trained volunteer and be Safe-Haven Certified.</p> <p>C. Only the diagonal system of control will be used to referee the games.</p> <p>D. Referees for U16/U19 games must be Advanced or above level. Referees for U14 games must be Advanced level or above. Referees for U12 games must be Intermediate level or above. Referees for U10 games must be Regional or above.</p> <p>E. Youth referees (center referees) must be at least 2 years older than the age group they are refereeing.</p> <p>F. All referees must be in full uniform as defined by AYSO and USSF, including the Referee Badge. Referees not in uniform will not be permitted to referee games, and their team's referee deposit may be subject to forfeiture.</p> <p>G. If all assignments are successfully completed, the Referee Deposit will be refunded (see REFEREE PLAN for more details).</p> <p>H. Referees are expected to check in at the Referee Station at least 30 minutes prior to their assigned game. Failure to appear on time may result in a replacement referee crew being assigned to the field. Once a replacement crew has been assigned, they will have priority and the original crew must report to the Referee station for alternative assignment.</p> <p>I. Coaches and players in the tournament will not be allowed to referee.</p> <p>J. Referees will be expected to uphold the tournament rules, AYSO Rules and Regulations and FIFA laws. Any failure of the referee to uphold these rules may be cause for dismissal from the tournament, and will place a team's referee deposit refund in jeopardy.</p>
<b>9) FIELDS</b>	<p>A. All fields will be set up and taken down by the tournament staff.</p> <p>B. Trash cans will be provided at each field. Teams will be expected to clean up all trash in their area before leaving.</p> <p>C. Please observe the following Facility Use Rules while attending the tournament: riding skateboards, bicycles, motor scooters, cigarette/cigar smoking, dogs, barbeques, weapons of any kind are not permitted at all soccer sites. There is no parking on the lawn areas and basketball courts. Double parking is not permitted. Vehicles that block emergency routes and driveways will be towed at owner's expense.</p>
<b>10) FORMAT</b>	<p>A. This is a pool-play tournament.</p> <p>B. Each age division will be bracketed into playing pools. Each team will play a minimum of 3 preliminary play games within their respective pools. Where there are sufficient teams, divisions will also be separated into multiple competition flights.</p> <p>C. Teams will advance from qualifying pools based on pool play standings points. Number of teams advancing per pool will be determined by the number of pools in the division.</p>
<b>11) CHECK-IN</b>	<p>A. Teams must check in 60 minutes prior to their first game, and must present Game Cards for as many games as the team will play in the tournament (including medal-round games). The Game Cards must be properly completed with the players listed by first name-last name in <u>jersey number order</u>. The players listed on the game cards must match the approved roster submitted with the team's application. All players listed on the roster must appear on each game card, even if there is an expectation that one (or more) might miss a scheduled game.</p> <p>B. Each coach or team representative must provide AYSO Player Registration Forms with original ink signatures for verification by tournament officials.</p> <p>C. Coaches must have these Player Registration Forms with them at all times and ready for presentation to</p>

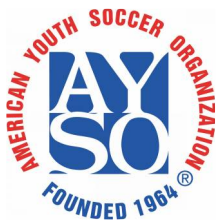


	<p>Tournament Officials.</p> <p>D. Late arriving players must be escorted to the check-in station by a team official along with their Player Registration Form, Player ID and be cleared by the Tournament Staff before participating in any games.</p>																		
<b>12) FIELD MONITORS</b>	<p>A. There will be a tournament Field Monitor assigned to each field, and will report to the Tournament Field Director. Field Monitors will check in teams prior to each game, and present the verified game cards to the match referees.</p> <p>B. At the conclusion of the game, the match referees must return the completed game cards to the Field Monitor.</p> <p>C. Field Monitors will be the first to respond to any incidents or injuries, and will be in contact with the rest of the tournament staff by radio. Tournament participants are encouraged to report any concerns immediately to the Field Monitor, and also to respectfully follow any instructions given by the Field Monitor.</p>																		
<b>13) GAMES</b>	<p>A. Pool play games will consist of 20 to 30 minute halves depending on the age division (see chart below) with a five minute half time. There will be a running clock during the match including substitutions. There will be no time added on for injuries or time wasted in qualifying rounds. Games will be expected to end on time, and may be shortened if they started late. Pool play games may end in a tie.</p> <p>B. Championship games' duration will be as shown below for that division. Championship games will be played until there is a winner (see Medal Round rules below).</p> <p>C. Game duration shall be as follows:</p> <table border="0" data-bbox="430 640 998 787"> <thead> <tr> <th><u>Division</u></th> <th><u>Pool Play, Semi-Final</u></th> <th><u>Final Round</u></th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td>U-10:</td> <td>20 minute half</td> <td>25 minute half</td> </tr> <tr> <td>U-12:</td> <td>25 minute half</td> <td>30 minute half</td> </tr> <tr> <td>U-14:</td> <td>25 minute half</td> <td>30 minute half</td> </tr> <tr> <td>U-16:</td> <td>30 minute half</td> <td>40 minute half</td> </tr> <tr> <td>U-19:</td> <td>30 minute half</td> <td>40 minute half</td> </tr> </tbody> </table> <p>D. The "home" team will be the first team or top team listed on the game schedule and will be responsible for providing the game ball. The home team will be situated on the North or West side of the field, and the visitor will be situated on the South or East side. Spectators must remain on the side of the field designated for their team. The home team will change jerseys or don pinnies in the event of a color conflict with the visitor team. The tournament will have overlays available. If any questions, the referee will determine whether this is necessary.</p> <p>E. There will be no warming up on the field. Teams must warm up prior to taking the field. As soon as the previous game has ended, teams must clear the field and the teams for the next game must take their places.</p> <p>F. There will be a running clock during all pool play games. There will be no time added on for injuries or time wasted during substitutions. Each coach is urged to have their team ready at the start of each half and to conduct substitutions in as expedient a manner as possible.</p> <p>G. FORFEITS: Teams must check in at the designated Field Coordinator Station 30 minutes prior to the start of the game. There will be a five-minute grace period at the start of the game for a team to take the field before a forfeit is declared. The score for a forfeit match will be 1-0 for the remaining team (See STANDINGS for the points to be awarded). For U-10 division teams, there is a minimum of 5 players on the field to continue a game. For U-12 the minimum number is 6 players. For all other divisions, there must be a minimum of 7 players to continue a game. If a team cannot field the minimum number of players, the game will be abandoned and a forfeit will be declared.</p> <p>H. SUSPENDED GAMES: The Tournament Committee may determine to end matches early if field schedule is behind due to game delays, interference, or if weather conditions provide unsafe conditions; and may distribute awards according to games played and points. The Tournament Committee will determine the outcome of any single game which is terminated prematurely (due to inclement weather, participant injury, or interference by outside party, etc.).</p> <p>I. ABANDONED GAMES: if any pool play games cannot be played due to circumstances beyond the control of the tournament, the final standings of the pool will be determined by applying the Winning Percentage formula (Total Points Earned in all Game Played divided by Total Points Possible for the Number of Games Played) to each team in the pool. Note. This does not apply to games which were shortened due to a late start. <b>14) SUBSTITUTIONS</b>	<p>A. Substitutions shall be allowed approximately mid way through each half for divisions U10 through U14, and will be recorded on the game cards by the referee.</p> <p>B. Substitutions in U16/U19 will be monitored substitution according to the AYSO Special Program for U16/U19 Play. Playing time for each player will be recorded on a special time monitoring form. Substitutions may be made at a stoppage of play as allowed by the referee.</p> <p>C. All substitutions must be approved and recognized by the referee. Substitutions may be made for injured players; however, they may not return until the beginning of the next quarter and will be considered as having played the current quarter (exception: an injured player not replaced may return to play at any time with the referee's permission).</p> <p>D. Substitutions in overtime periods of medal round matches will be at the beginning of each period only.</p>																		
<b>15) STANDINGS</b>	<p>A.
